Last Time Out

Continuing his rage of scoring, senior Ben Rayhorn one-upped his career-high from three days ago vs. Trinity International with 31 points against Purdue-North Central in the CCAC Tournament First Round win, 86-78. Rayhorn hit five three-pointers and was 11-of-18 from the floor to lead Judson. Adding to Rayhorn's 31 points was Josh Edwards with 15 points, Jim Kuban with 14 points, and Josh Weber with 10 points. Judson finished shooting 51% from the floor, 30% from three-point range, and 54% from the stripe. Purdue-North Central shot 39% from the floor, 27% from beyond the arc, and 71% from the line. Judson blocked five shots and forced 14 turnovers. They also won the rebounding contest, 45-35.

Career-Highs

Ben Rayhorn topped his career-high of 24 points with 31 vs. Purdue-North Central in the CCAC Tournament first round win. He hit five three-pointers in the win and had some key buckets to give Judson the win. With 11:33 left in the game, Purdue-North Central tied the game at 57 and then took the lead just 40 seconds later on two free throws by JF Ndomb. From that point on (10:35 left), Rayhorn single handedly went on a 10-2 run over a minute and 15 seconds to put Judson up by eight, 67-59.


2nd Half of the Season

After starting 1-10, Judson has won 14 of their last 16 games. The only two losses have come to CCAC Champion #9 Cardinal Stritch. Judson is currently on a five-game winning streak and won 11 out of their last 12 games.

NAIA

Judson is 4th in the nation in assists per game with 17.9 and 13th in assists (485). They are also 9th in scoring offense (85.7), 10th in field goal percentage (.489), and 14th in defensive rebounds/game (27.6). Individually, Jim Kuban is tied for 13th in assists per game (5.0) and assists (135). Josh Edwards is 21st in three-point field goals made per game at 2.85.

the coach - Tony Tompkins



Tompkins is in his third year at Judson and second as the head coach. He came to Judson from Missouri Baptist where he was the coach for five years. He compiled over 100 wins and won three conference championships, and went to two NAIA Division I National Tournaments. In his first year at Judson, they won the CCAC regular season title.

Last Time Out

Trinity Christian held off a strong Trinity International team in the CCAC Tournament First Round, 77-72. With the game tied at 72 with 1:21 left on the clock, TIU turned the ball over which turned into a three-point play by Will Bruinsma at the other end with 51 seconds left. Trinity Christian then held onto the victory. Bruinsma led the team with 22 points while Matt Buren had 14 points, Josh Flikkema 11 points, and Brendan Vize with 10 points.

Last Time vs. Judson

Judson pulled off a 78-73 win in Palos Heights as they outscored the Trolls, 9-2, in the final five minutes. Trinity Christian had a two point lead, 71-69, when Judson made their move for the win. Jim Kuban led Judson with 20 points while Matt Buren had 24 for Trinity Christian.

Deja Vu

Last year at this time, both Judson and Trinity Christian met in the quarterfinal game with a trip to the championship game on the line in. Judson hosted the game but fell to the Trolls, 91-79. Trinity Christian went on to defeat Cardinal Stritch for the CCAC Tournament Championship.
