Judson Notes

Last Time Out
Coming down to the final four minutes of the game, Judson University did not hit a shot from the floor as #14 Cornerstone University held onto an 88-82 win. Judson had a four-point lead with 4:19 left in the game. Landon Skinner and Josh Weber led four Judson players in double figures as they both had 16 points. Marios Lobdell added 15 and Hoskins had 12.

Career-High and Firsts

Three players received their first starts of the year with two getting their first career start against Cornerstone. LeStan Hoskins had his first start of the season and then Michael Wood and Anthony Ahlers both received their first career starts at Judson. Wood made the most of his first start with a career-high nine points, seven rebounds, and four steals in 37 minutes of play.

Notes From Clarke College Game

The 78% free throw shooting was the best shooting percentage of the season for Judson from the line...the 22% 3-point shooting was the second worst of the season...13 turnovers for Judson was the second lowest of the season...this was the second game in a row that Judson out rebounded their opponent (38-34, 40-35 vs. Clarke)...this is the second ranked opponent and third game this season facing ranked opponent...Judson has faced #2 Bethel (IN) twice...Marios Lobdell has shot perfect from the line in three games this year (2-2, 2-2, twice)...this was the 8th game this season that Judson shot 40% or better.

the coach - Tony Tompkins



Tompkins is in his third year at Judson and second as the head coach. He came to Judson from Missouri Baptist where he was the coach for five years. He compiled over 100 wins and won three conference championships, and went to two NAIA Division I National Tournaments. In his first year at Judson, they won the CCAC regular season title.

College of the Ozarks Notes

Last Time Out
Winning their third game of the season, College of the Ozarks won the consolation game at the Viterbo Classic over Silver Lake College, 74-64. Dustin Todd had 17 points followed by Craig Campbells 14 and Jared Howerton's 13. Howerton also led the team with nine rebounds. C of O had a 13-point lead in the first five minutes and as large as a 19-point lead in the second half. They finished shooting 49% from the floor, 20% from beyond the arc, and 68% from the stripe. They had 24 turnovers and 11 steals.

Tough Schedule

In their first nine games, C of O has played seven NAIA Division I programs, one NCAA Division II program, and one independant. Judson will be their first NAIA Division II opponent this year. They have also only been home only twice this year playing in Missouri, Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Wisconsin.

NAIA National Tournament

Last year, C of O finished third in their MCAC but made a run in the NAIA National Tournament where they finished as the runners-up. They have won one NAIA National Championship in the last seven years and appeared in seven straight national tournaments.

Shepherd is in his eighth season at College of the Ozarks and has led the Bobcats to seven straight NAIA Division II National Tournaments. He has won one NAIA National Championship, two conference tournament championships, and one national coach of the year award. Prior to C of O, he was an assistant for four years at Evangel University where he was a part of a NAIA National Championship, also.
