Judson notes

Senior Night

Today is senior day for five seniors in Nate McNeely, LeStan Hoskins, Michael Wood, Josh Weber, and Ben Rayhorn. All have been a part of the program for two years and helped Judson to a CCAC regular season championship last year.

Last Time Out

Judson University was able to escape with a CCAC win against Trinity Christian after scoring 47 second half points to move above .500. Jim Kuban tied his career high with 20 points along with seven rebounds while playing all 40 minutes of the game. Ben Rayhorn led the way for the Eagles on the boards with a 11 rebounds to go along with his 14 points. Josh Edwards finished with 18 points and Landon Skinner had 11.

Career-Highs

Jim Kuban had a career-high of 10 rebounds vs. Purdue-Calumet and then followed that by tying his career-high of 20 points vs. Trinity Christian. Against Purdue-Calumet, he was one assist shy of a triple-double.

Countdown to 1,000 Points

Landon Skinner needs only 10 points to break 1,000 career points. He would be the 26th player in Judson history to break the 1,000 point barrier.

.500, YES !!!

With the win over Trinity Christian, Judson moved their record to above .500 for the first time since being 1-0. Judson started of the season 1-10 before winning their second game. Judson will be the #2 seed in the CCAC Tournament.

NAIA

Josh Edwards is currently 14th in the NAIA for 3-point field goal percentage (.432) and 21st in 3-point field goals made per game (2.92). Jim Kuban is 16th in assists per game (4.8) and 23rd in assists (121). As a team, Judson is 3rd in assists per game (17.68), 12th in scoring offense (84.9), and 19th in assists (442).

the coach - Tony Tompkins



Tompkins is in his third year at Judson and second as the head coach. He came to Judson from Missouri Baptist where he was the coach for five years. He compiled over 100 wins and won three conference championships, and went to two NAIA Division I National Tournaments. In his first year at Judson, they won the CCAC regular season title.

Last Time Out

Trinity International fell to Trinity Christian, 86-81, in the final five minutes of the game. With under five to go, TIU was within three points but could not get any closer. The Trojans were led by Patrick Atkins' 24 points. Tyrone Smith added 21 points while Ignas Verbas had 20 points.

Last time vs. Judson

Perseverance was the key word for Judson University as they made a late run in the second half to put away the game against Trinity International, 89-72. With less than 10 minutes to go in the game, Judson had only a four-point lead but went on a 10-0 run over the next five minutes to put away the game with a 14-point lead. Judson's defense also provided, again, as they had nine blocks. Five players scored in double figures for Judson as Landon Skinner had 24 points. Patrick Atkins had 25 points for TIU.

CCAC Seedings - TIU

With the #1, 2, and 3 seeds set, the CCAC is looking for the final seedings this weekend. Either Trinity International or Calumet will be the No. 4 seed and will host the No. 5 seed on Tuesday. Trinity International will be the No. 4 seed if they defeat Judson on Saturday and Calumet would be the No. 5 seed. If Trinity International loses, Calumet will be the No. 4 seed and Trinity International will either be the No. 5 or 6 seed. They will be the No. 5 seed if Calumet defeats Purdue-Calumet and the No. 6 seed if Purdue-Calumet wins.

the coach - Andy Euler



Euler is in his second year at Trinity International after coming from Covenant College. Before Covenant, he was the boys coach at Wheaton Academy where he had a 258-171 record. He has also coached at Alaska-Fairbanks and Pillsbury College in Minnesota.
