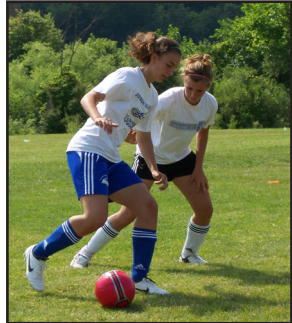

Camp Information

Residents:

Resident campers will be housed in university residence halls and will be supervised by our camp staff. Campers must bring their own sheets, pillows, toiletry and clothing needs. Three daily meals are served in the large dining hall. More information will be provided upon confirmation of registration.

Roommates:

Campers must request their roommate on the registration form. If no roommate is requested, one will be assigned.

Registration:

A deposit of \$100.00 payable to Judson University must accompany the registration form. The balance of the fees are payable upon arrival at camp. Confirmation of registration will be sent upon receipt of the registration form and the camp deposit.

Team discounts of 10% will be given to teams of 6 or more. We are also offering a \$100 discount for attending both overnight weeks.
